SOME COMMON LANDSCAPE PLANTS THAT CAN BE GROWN INSIDE

PALMS & FERNS		
Botanical Name	Common Name	Indoor Care & Needs
Adiantum capillus-veneris	Maidenhair Fern	Indirect Light; Summer temps max 70F, winter max 50F; does not like to be dry, when hot mist & water 2/week, when cool 1/week
Asperagus densiflorus ‘Myers’	Plume Asparagus Fern	Indirect Light; Summer temps 55-60F, winter 50F; in summer mist & water 2-3/week, in winter 1/week
Asperagus densiflorus ‘Sprengeri’	Sprenger Asparagus Fern	Indirect Light; Summer temps 55-75F, winter min 45F; in summer mist & water 2-3/week, in winter 1/week
Butia capitata	Pindo Palm	Full Sun to Part Shade; temps in summer 70-80F, winter 50-70F; in summer mist & water 2-3/week, allow to almost dry btwn. winter watering – needs good drainage
Chamaerops humilis	Mediterranean Fan Palm	Full Sun; average temps of 40-60F; summer & winter mist & water 2/week, does not like to be dry
Cycas revoluta	Sago Palm	Indirect Light in Summer, direct Light in Winter; in summer mist & water daily, in winter 2/week – good drainage
Cyrtomium falcatum	Holly Leaf Fern	Indirect Light; Cool temps 50-66F year round; in summer mist & water 2-3/week, in winter 1/week
Phoenix canariensis	Canary Island Date Palm	Full sun with age; temps in summer 80F, winter 50F; in summer mist & water 2/week, winter should almost dry btwn. watering – needs good drainage
Polystichum tsus-simense	Korean Rock Fern	Indirect Light or shade; Year round 65-75F preferred; in summer mist & water 3-4/week, in winter it likes drier 1-3/week
Selaginella uncinata	Peacock Moss	Indirect Light; Summer temps max 65F, winter min 55F; Must be kept moist, good in terrariums

FLOWERING PLANTS		
Botanical Name	Common Name	Indoor Care & Needs
Abutilon species	Flowering Maple	Indirect Light; temps 65-70F; in summer water daily (not soggy) & mist 2/week avoiding flowers; in winter water when dry don't mist
Azalea		Indirect Light; temps 55-60F preferred; Water daily to keep soil moist but not soggy & mist daily avoiding flowers
Brunfelsia pauciflora	Yesterday-today- and tomorrow	Indirect Light when growing flowering, direct OK between then; temps 60-70F in spring/summer, reduce temps gradually into winter 48F; in summer water & mist 2/week keeping moist (avoid flowers), in winter allow to dry btwn. watering
Callistemon citrinus	Bottlebrush	Bright Indirect Light; comfortable room temp in summer, temp 45-50F in winter; in summer water 2/week & mist 1/week, keep drier in winter with 1/week watering
Camellia japonica	Camellia	Bright Indirect Light; spring summer temps 65-70F, winter 55-60F; in fall thru spring water 2/week (no standing water), 1/week in summer, mist weekly
Gardenia jasminoides	Common Gardenia	Bright Indirect Light; Spring/Summer temps 65-70F (75 max), winter min 50F; Spring/Summer water 2-3/week & mist daily, winter 1/week allow to dry some
Gerbera jamesonii	Transvaal Daisy	Bright Indirect Light; Temps min 45F summer max 65-70F best; in summer water 2-3/week & mist 1-2/week, winter water every other week (drying out btwn)
Hydrangea macrophylla		Bright Indirect Light; winter temps 45F, raise to 55F in spring max 65F summer; in summer water regularly to keep soil moist, mist daily
Jasminum polyanthum	Pink Jasmine	Bright Indirect Light; summer temps 60-65F, winter 45-50F; in spring water 2-3/week, spring-summer keeping moist but not soggy & mist daily avoiding flowers, winter water only when dry

FLOWERING PLANTS		
Botanical Name	Common Name	Indoor Care & Needs
Lantana		Full Sun; temps in summer 65F, winter min 55F; water when dry maybe 1-2/week do not let stand in water, should not need misting
Leptospermum scoparium	New Zealand Tea Tree	Full Sun; Temps fall-winter 50-60F, summer 80F or higher; spring-summer water to keep moist, can be drier in winter, no misting
Osmanthus fragrans	Sweet Olive	Bright Indirect Light (move outdoors in summer if possible to boost flower production); temps 50-70F; spring summer keep moist, mist daily, winter allow to dry btwn waterings
Passiflora caerulea	Passion Flower Vine	Full Sun; temps spring-summer 65-75F, winter 55-65F; spring to summer water every 2 days when hot, mist 2-3/week, winter when dry 1/week
Plumbago auriculata	Cape Plumbago	Bright Indirect Light; temps winter 45F, spring-summer 55-70F; spring-summer water 2/week keeping moist & mist daily, winter water 1/week when dry - no standing water
Strelitzia reginae	Bird of Paradise	Bright Indirect Light or Full Sun; winter min temp 50F summer max 75F; in summer water 3/week keeping soil moist but not soggy & mist daily, winter 1/week
Tibouchina urvilleana	Princess Flower	Bright Indirect Light; prefers daytime temps of 65-75F, nighttime 50-60F; when warm water to keep evenly moist, in winter allow to dry just a little, no misting required

FOLIAGE PLANTS		
Botanical Name	Common Name	Indoor Care & Needs
Aspidistra elatior	Cast Iron Plant	Indirect Light to Dark Corners; average room temps 50-65F best; soil surface should dry btwn waterings, summer water 2/week, winter 1/week
Fatsia japonica	Japanese Aralia	Full Sun to Dark Corners; temps from 32F to 70F; summer keep moist watering 2/week & mist daily if hot, winter water 1/week but never drying out
Grevillea robusta	Silk Oak	Full Sun; temps in winter 45-50F, normal room temps in summer up to 70F; summer water to keep moist up to 3/week & mist 2/week, winter water 1/week
Hedera canariensis	Algerian Ivy	Bright Indirect Light; temps 60-65F best; in summer water 2/week & mist daily when warm/dry, winter water 1/week drying some btwn watering
Hedera helix	English Ivy	Full Sun to Bright Indirect Light; temps in summer 60-65F, winter min 45F; summer water 2/week & mist daily, winter 1/week & mist when dry
Podocarpus macrophyllus	Yew Pine	Bright Light; temps above 45F in winter, summer room temp to 75F; keep moist, in summer water 2/week & mist 2-3/week, in winter water & mist 1/week - no standing water
Scirpus cernus	Fiber Optic Grass	Bright Indirect Light; temps 55-75F best, min 45F; keep moist year round watering 2-3/week & mist daily especially when dry
Tradescantia virginiana	Spiderwort	Bright Indirect Light to Low Light; temps winter min 50F, normal room temp in summer; summer water 2/week & mist bi-weekly, winter water 1/week

Artemisia dracunculus	Tarragon	Full Sun or Bright Indirect Light; average temps 60-65F are best; water when top 1' of soil surface is dry, misting is not needed
Cymbopogon citrinus	Lemon Grass	
Laurus nobilis	Grecian/Sweet Bay	
Lavandula	Lavender	
Mentha piperita	Mint	
Origanum vulgare	Oregano	
Rosmarinus officinallis	Rosemary
