How We Are Organized:

- Every row has LETTERS (the block code) followed by NUMBERS (the row number) to denote a specific location at the tree farm.
 Example: TA4, RR56, M51 etc...
- Plant locations can be found on the availability tab at urbantreefarm.com
- If you find a plant you like and cannot bring it to the front let us know the block code and row number and our crew will bring it to the parking lot or mark it as sold.

Items Not For Sale:

Some items are in the process of growing or are sold to other customers. Here's what to look for:

• Red flags placed at the corner of a block means the WHOLE GROUP of plants are

still growing and are therefore NOT FOR SALE.

- Plants with SOLD TAGS or COLORED TAPE individually tied or wrapped around a group means they are sold to other customers. Removal of sold tags or tape is considered theft and will result in a permanent ban from our nursery.
- We have a receiving area marked with signage for special order plants. These plants are already sold to other customers and cannot be removed from the area.This includes plants on the ground, on trailers, and on wooden or metal standing racks.

• If you see something of interest, bring the information to the front desk and we can check to see if there are more available elsewhere. Newly received plant material will not reflect on the website.
